**In Church** The Rosary will be recited publicly after Mass at 09:45am on Wednesdays (after the 09:15am Mass). All welcome.

**Children's liturgy** starts again on 22<sup>nd</sup> May. This will take place during the 10:30am Mass on Sundays, during term-time. Children's liturgy is for our youngest parishioners, so that they can hear the Word of God proclaimed in a language more appropriate to their levels of understanding. It is aimed at children from birth through to Year 3 at school (when they typically make their First Holy Communion) - if your child is below nursery age and comes along, they will need someone with them. The liturgy usually includes singing, learning about the Gospel, prayer, and some sort of activity—often to do with marker pens. We are looking forward to seeing you at the Children's Liturgy, and we thank you for your continued prayers for this ministry and the children of our parish.
