Pentecost Sunday

Fr. Duncan writes: Today we celebrate Pentecost Sunday, the last great day of the Easter Festival. This is the day the Church's work of bringing the Gospel to all peoples began. We come together, like the Lord's disciples at the first Pentecost, in response to our Lord's instructions, to celebrate our birth as the Church, the people of the new covenant, called to announce God's almighty works of creation and salvation by our behaviour in our daily lives, inspired by the Holy Spirit. Pentecost is a missionary feast that celebrates the Spirit that gives energy to the Church in proclaiming the Risen Christ. God's Spirit is among us, inspiring us and uniting us, that we too may be apostles of God's love. As we celebrate this great feast, let us hear and respond to its call to mission, to proclaim the truth and joy of the Gospel. And so, let us pray, on this Pentecost Sunday, for a re-awakening of the fire of the Holy Spirit in our hearts and in our lives. We ask the Spirit to empower and energise us as we look at the needs of our parish community and then initiate ways of addressing those needs.

Car Park Barrier

Work has begun to reclaim our car park for our use. You will see the groundwork has been completed to enable a control barrier to be installed at the entrance to the car park. The barrier system is now being manufactured for our site and will be installed in the next week or so. At the exit single flow plates will be installed to allow cars to exit into West Way, but not enter the car park from West Way. Once the barrier has been installed full details will be available how this will operate. There will be access cards, for those who need them.

On Sundays the barrier will be open during Mass times. There will be teething problems and maybe some difficulties as we get used to the system, but it is the only way we can regain control of our car park for our use. Please be patient as we become familiar with the new system.
