We will begin this in September. It will give us an opportunity to spend some time in prayer before Our Lord in the Blessed Sacrament praying for our needs and the needs of our world. Please try and join us, even for a short time during the hour.

Car Park Barrier

If the code becomes widely known the barrier becomes ineffective! If the code does not open the barrier, it may have been changed. You will therefore have to park somewhere else and check the code in use. The one way system through the car park remains in operation. DO NOT attempt to enter from West Way. There are one way flow plates/teeth that will damage tyres! On Sundays the barrier will be open during Mass times.
