Fr. Duncan writes: Dear Parishioners, yesterday, **Saturday 24th June**, there was a great celebration in Westminster Cathedral as seven men were ordained as priests to serve us in the Diocese of Westminster. Among those ordained was Joseph Okoro. On Sunday Fr Joseph will be celebrating his first Mass in his home parish of St Erconwald, Wembley.

Fr Joseph will celebrate a first Mass here in our parish on Tuesday evening, the Feast of St John Southworth at **8.00pm**. After the Mass he will give first blessings and there will be a reception in the hall after Mass. Then on the following **Sunday 2nd July** he will celebrate the **10.00am** Mass. After both Masses he will be offering first blessings. Many thanks for the donation for the collection for Joseph, if you would like to donate there is still time as we be presenting Joseph with his cheque on Tuesday evening.

Please pray for all these new priests as they begin their ministry in our diocese.

Holiday of Obligation

On Thursday we celebrate the Feast of Saints Peter and Paul, two great pillars of the Church, two founding members of the Christian Faith. Peter, a fisherman turned leader and Paul, Christian persecutor turned Christian preacher. Both these men were transformed when they came into a closer relationship with God. As we celebrate this feast let us remember our Holy Father, Pope Francis. We pray for him that his faith may be strengthened as he leads and guides the Church. Masses in our church for the feast are Wednesday **8.00pm** (Vigil Mass) and Thursday at **8.00am, 10.00am and 8.00pm**.

Car Park Barrier

The car park barrier has now been installed and is in operation. During the coming week cards and codes are being issued to regular users. It is very important that if you have the car park code you treat it in the same way as your bank PIN number. Do not give the code to anyone. If the code becomes widely known the barrier becomes ineffective! The one way system through the car park remains in operation. DO NOT attempt to enter from West Way. There are one way flow plates that will damage tyres!

For weekend Masses the barrier will be open during Mass times. There will be teething problems and maybe some difficulties as we get used to the system, but it is the only way we can regain control of our car park for our use. Please be patient as we become familiar with the new system.

St. Edmund Campion Relic

On **Wednesday 5th July** at **10am** Mass and **Friday 7th July** at **8pm** Mass the Relic of St Edmund Campion will be brought to our church. Each year the Relic of St Edmund Campion is carried from Lyford Grange, near Wantage, where St Edmund was arrested and brought on pilgrimage to Tyburn where he was executed. This pilgrimage is organised each year by the Knights of St Columba and the relic comes to various churches on route to Tyburn Convent. The intention for the pilgrimage is Christian Unity and World Peace. We have the honour of receiving the relic here in our parish. At the end of each Mass there will be the opportunity to venerate the relic.

Sacred Heart Summer Club
