26th Sunday in Ordinary Time

Fr. Duncan writes: This weekend a further 35 children will be receiving Jesus for the first time in the Sacrament of the Eucharist. Our Parish First Holy Communions are important not just for the children and their families, but for all in our parish. Many of us will remember our First Holy Communion day. It was a special day, as we received Jesus for the first time in Holy Communion. Each time we come to Mass we are encouraged to receive Holy Communion. Being fed and nourished by the Lord in Word and Sacrament is vital in our lives. Please pray for these children, their parents and catechists as they complete their preparations for these special days. I am particularly grateful to Jo Marsh and her team of catechists, who have been teaching the children and have prepared them to receive this Sacrament. Please keep them all in your prayers. These Masses are by invitation only, because of the limited space available in the church.

The Covid19 virus is still spreading. We need to be vigilant. In the church we are doing our best to create a safe environment to welcome all who come to Mass. This means that many of the measures we have put in place will remain, and we will keep to the ways we have become accustomed to when we come into the church. Please continue to wear facemasks in the church and sanitise your hands as you enter the church. We will maintain the social distanced seating until we are advised otherwise.

You will still need to register for Sunday Masses (Saturday 6.00pm, Sunday 9.00am, 10.30am, 12.00 noon and 6.00pm) as before. This is to ensure we keep within the Covid secure capacity of our church.
