8th Sunday in Ordinary Time

Fr. Duncan writes: Wednesday this week is Ash Wednesday, the beginning of the Season of Lent. Masses on Ash Wednesday are at **10.00am** and **8.00pm**. Ashes will be blessed and distributed at each Mass. Please Note: Ash Wednesday is a day of Fast and Abstinence.

During Lent, it is traditional for us to 'give up' something we like, as a penance. This we should all try to do. Fasting is an important way to keep Lent. But I would also like to encourage you to be positive and take on something extra during Lent as well. This is part of our spiritual preparation for the celebration of Christ's Resurrection at Easter. During Lent, we are encouraged to take on an extra spiritual exercise or devotion, for example coming to weekday Mass, maybe some spiritual reading or Walking the Way of the Cross. Here in our parish during Lent we will be having Stations of the Cross each Friday at **7.30pm** followed by Mass at **8.00pm**. Now is the time for us to decide what we will be doing during Lent this year. Then we will be ready to begin on Wednesday.

Lenten Alms

These are collected throughout Lent. This year the Cardinal has decided that the money will be used to support the Cardinal's Appeal. This money is used within our Diocese to support among other things, enabling people living on the margins live a life of dignity. There is a box by the second Station for Lenten Alms donations.
