Next Saturday is the Diocesan Pilgrimage Walsingham. We have a group going on pilgrimage from our parish. This pilgrimage is organised each year by the Knights of St Columba and the relic comes to various churches on route to Tyburn Convent. We have the honour of receiving the relic here in our parish. At the end of each Mass there will be the opportunity to venerate the relic.
