### 17th Sunday in Ordinary Time

**Fr. Duncan writes:** This Sunday a group of our parishioners and I will be travelling to Lourdes with many other pilgrims from all over the Diocese of Westminster, on pilgrimage to the Shrine of Our Lady of Lourdes. We fly out from Stansted Airport on Sunday afternoon, arriving in Lourdes in time for dinner at our hotel. After dinner, no doubt, we will make our first visit to the grotto. That is the master plan, let us hope and pray that all goes smoothly.

On Monday morning, we shall gather, as the Diocese of Westminster on Pilgrimage, and pass through the Holy Door at the Breton Cross and then assemble for the opening Mass at Basilica St Bernadette. On Friday our closing Mass will be at the grotto. Fr Duncan will be offering this Mass for all the pilgrims and parishioners of Most Sacred Heart Parish, Ruislip and for their intentions. If you are able, please try to come to Mass on Friday morning to pray with us. If you are unable to come to Mass on Friday, please join us in prayer by saying, for example, a decade of the Rosary. Throughout the week our Mass on each day is in various different chapels and churches in Lourdes. During the week I shall 'post' your petitions at the grotto in Lourdes and before we leave on Saturday I will light a candle at the grotto for the intentions of all in our parish. Please keep us in your prayers, during this week. We shall remember you all in our prayers in Lourdes.

Over the next few weeks many of our parishioners will be setting off on holiday. To all those who are going away on holiday I hope you have a good break and a chance to relax and 'recharge the batteries' for the autumn. To those of us who will be at home, we too hope for some sun and the chance to relax.
