## 31st Sunday in Ordinary Time

**Fr. Duncan writes:** On Tuesday this week we celebrate the Feast of All Saints, a Holiday of Obligation. Masses for the Feast are on **Monday 8.00pm, Tuesday 8.00am, 10.00am** and **8.00pm**. This feast gives us an opportunity to praise God for all those people, who in day-to-day life have responded to the challenge presented in the Gospel. They have responded generously to what God has asked of them. We remember, with gratitude and joy, all those who have gone before us in faith and are now enjoying the reward of their labours in the kingdom of heaven.

**Wednesday 2<sup>nd</sup> November**, is the Commemoration of All Souls, when we remember all those who have died, and 'gone before us marked with the sign of faith'. Masses are at **8.00am, 10.00am** and **8.00pm**. On this day and throughout the month of November we pray especially for all the souls in purgatory.

Throughout the month Mass will be offered in our church for all whose names are listed on our November Roll of the Dead. These names will be placed in the sanctuary throughout the month.
