On Sundays the barrier will be open during Mass times. There will be teething problems and maybe some difficulties as we get used to the system, but it is the only way we can regain control of our car park for our use. Please be patient as we become familiar with the new system.

Building on Success at Salvatorian College

You may have noticed some changes if you have passed Salvatorian College recently, with the erection of hoardings to enable preparatory works for the College Rebuild. Over the summer Kier Construction will take over the site and begin works to demolish existing buildings to enable the first phase of new building. This is a significant milestone in the transformation of the College, building on a 'Good' Ofsted rating awarded in January, and having achieving the highest percentage of A*-C GCSE passes and highest attainment for boys in Harrow last year. St. Edmund Campion Relic

On **Wednesday 5th July** at **10am** Mass and **Friday 7th July** at **8pm** Mass the Relic of St Edmund Campion will be brought to our church. Each year the Relic of St Edmund Campion is carried from Lyford Grange, near Wantage, where St Edmund was arrested and brought on pilgrimage to Tyburn where he was executed. This pilgrimage is organised each year by the Knights of St Columba and the relic comes to various churches on route to Tyburn Convent. The intention for the pilgrimage is Christian Unity and World Peace. We have the honour of receiving the relic here in our parish. At the end of each Mass there will be the opportunity to venerate the relic.

Sacred Heart Summer Club

Summer Club will be running **31st July - 4th August** and **7th - 11th August, 9am - 5pm**, with an optional early start of **8.30am** including breakfast. The cost is £35 per day or £160 per week. The club is being held at the Willow Tree centre, Breakspear Road. All adults are DBS checked and there are at least two first aiders present at all times.
