Corpus Christi

Fr. Duncan writes: Today we celebrate the Feast of Corpus Christi, the Body and Blood of Christ. It is a time to reflect and celebrate in greater depth and with sharper awareness what we do each week as we come to Mass. We come together to give thanks to God for His Greatest Gift to us, His Son Jesus Christ, in the great Sacrament of the Eucharist. Since the very early days of the Church the early Christians have been gathering together for this sacred meal. When we routinely do anything, we can lose sight of just how wonderful it is. On this Feast of Corpus Christi we are reflecting on just how wonderful it is to be called by the Lord to gather in his presence, to be a guest at his table, and to eat and drink from his wonderful bounty. As we come together to celebrate this Mass we are accepting the Lord's invitation and communing with him in this mystery by receiving the sacrament of his body and blood.

On Friday this week we celebrate the Feast of the Most Sacred Heart of Jesus, our Parish Feast Day. We focus on the heart as the great symbol of love and compassion. As we celebrate this feast, we are reminded of the Sacred Heart of Jesus, God's Son who loves us so intensely and deeply. Let us pray for all in our parish, especially the sick and housebound and the bereaved. Let us also remember all our parishioners and benefactors who have gone before us, marked with the sign of faith. May they rest in peace. There will be two Masses in our church on Friday, **10.00am** and **8.00pm**, there is no Friday abstinence on this day.

Car Park Barrier

The car park barrier has now been installed and is in operation. During the coming week cards and codes will be issued to regular users. It is very important that if you have the car park code you treat it in the same way as your bank PIN number. **Do not give the code to anyone.** If the code becomes widely known the barrier becomes ineffective! The one way system through the car park remains in operation. **DO NOT** attempt to enter from West Way. There are one way flow plates that will damage your tyres!

For weekend Masses the barrier will be open during Mass times. There will be teething problems and maybe some difficulties as we get used to the system, but it is the only way we can regain control of our car park for our use. Please be patient as we become familiar with the new system.
