## 15<sup>th</sup> Sunday in Ordinary Time

Your petition should be written out and placed in an envelope marked 'Petition to Our Lady of Lourdes' and sealed.

### Car Park Barrier

I hope you are now finding it much easier to park on weekdays, as we now have more control of our car park. The code is available to regular parish users from Fr Duncan or group leaders. You will therefore have to park somewhere else and check the code in use. The one way system through the car park remains in operation. DO NOT attempt to enter from West Way. There are one way flow plates/teeth that will damage tyres! On Sundays the barrier will be open during Mass times.
