## 30<sup>th</sup> Sunday of the Year

**Fr. Duncan writes:** Dear Parishioners, on **Wednesday** this week we celebrate the **Feast of All Saints**, a Holiday of Obligation. Masses for the Feast are on **Tuesday 8.00pm, Wednesday 8.00am, 10.00am and 8.00pm.** This feast gives us an opportunity to praise God for all those people, who in day-to-day life have responded to the challenge presented in the Gospel. They have responded generously to what God has asked of them. We remember, with gratitude and joy, all those who have gone before us in faith and are now enjoying the reward of their labours in the kingdom of heaven.

**Thursday 2<sup>nd</sup> November**, is the **Commemoration of All Souls**, when we remember all those who have died, and 'gone before us marked with the sign of faith'. Masses are at **8.00am, 10.00am and 8.00pm.** On this day and throughout the month of November we pray especially for all the souls in purgatory.

## Month of the Holy Souls

November is the month of the Holy Souls when we remember especially those who have died and gone before us 'marked with the sign of faith'. Throughout the month Mass will be offered in our church for all whose names are listed on our November Roll of the Dead. These names will be placed in the sanctuary throughout the month. If you would like the names of your deceased relatives and friends included, please take an envelope from the table at the back of the church and return it with your list enclosed to one of the priests or to the presbytery. Your offering may be placed in the envelope.

## Statement on Abortion

This statement, published by the Catholic Bishops of England, Wales and Scotland, on the occasion of the 50th anniversary of the 1967 UK Abortion Act, is addressed not only to Catholics of our countries, but more broadly to all people who seek to uphold the dignity of human life and protect the unborn child. Over the last fifty years, the bishops of our countries, along with many other people, have spoken consistently in favour of the intrinsic value of human life and both the good of the child in the womb and the good of the mother. This anniversary provides an opportunity to lament the loss of life due to abortion and seek a change of minds and hearts about the good of the child in the womb and the care of mothers who are pregnant.

### Jubilee Trust Lottery
