Jubilee Trust Lottery

The Jubilee Trust, our Parish Charity, was instigated in 1981 to mark the Diamond Jubilee of Ruislip Parish. We aim to raise money and then use that money to help those who are in poverty or living with ill-health and to help spread Christianity. One of our main fund raisers each year is The Lottery, (formerly 200 Club) which is a monthly draw for a cash prizes between £50 and £500. We need at least 200 people It costs £20 for a year's subscription. About half the money raised is used as prizes, and the balance is used by the Jubilee Trust for various projects. Lottery Letters with details of how to join or re-join the Lottery are available from the upstand on the table at the back of the Church. The next cycle of draws will start in December with the first draw for £500 will be held after the Carol Service on **Sunday 17th December**.
