5th Sunday of Easter

Fr. Duncan writes: This afternoon thousands of people will be gathering at different places around the coast of the British Isles to pray the Rosary. *Rosary on the Coast* is a wonderful initiative as groups from all over the country are gathering together to pray the Rosary at **3.00pm** this **Sunday 29th April**. The object is very simple: to give witness as we pray for our country at this moment in time, for peace and God's blessing and the protection of Our Lady. Please come and join us at **3.00pm** in our church and pray the Rosary with us. If you cannot get to the church, then join us by praying the Rosary at home on Sunday afternoon.

The Priest Training Fund Collection

Very many thanks for your generosity in last weekend's collection for the Priest Training Fund (WEEF). A total of £1364.91 was collected. The Arena will be the home to a six-hour stage programme on the **8th September** and will include a Congress Mass, keynote speakers *Bishop Robert Barron* and *Cardinal Vincent Nicholas*, and a drama highlighting the beauty of reverence and devotion.
