## 13<sup>th</sup> Sunday of Ordinary Time

She has worked with the First Reconciliation and First Holy Communion children, the Confirmation Candidates, the Sunday Group Children – Children in non-Catholic schools, the Children's Liturgy. She has supported the days of Reconciliation for readers and Eucharistic Ministers. On **Sunday 15<sup>th</sup> July** at the **10am** Mass we will formally thank Sandra for all she has done for our parish during this time.

### St. Edmund Campion Relic

On **Wednesday 4<sup>th</sup> July** at **10am** Mass and **Friday 6<sup>th</sup> July** at **8pm** Mass the Relic of St Edmund Campion will be brought to our church. Each year the Relic of St Edmund Campion is carried from Lyford Grange, near Wantage, where St Edmund was arrested and brought on pilgrimage to Tyburn where he was executed. This pilgrimage is organised each year by the Knights of St Columba and the relic comes to various churches on route to Tyburn Convent. We have the honour of receiving the relic here in our parish. At the end of each Mass there will be the opportunity to venerate the relic.

### Pilgrimage to Lourdes

Towards the end of this month, a group of us will be setting off from our parish to join the Westminster Diocesan Pilgrimage to Lourdes. The pilgrimage will be led by our Archbishop, Cardinal Vincent Nichols, and the auxiliary bishops. If you would like us to take any petitions to Our Lady of Lourdes, these may be handed to Fr Duncan or posted through the letter box of the priests' house. Your petition should be written out and placed in an envelope marked 'Petition to Our Lady of Lourdes' and sealed.

Our first meeting of the new 'term' will be towards the end of September at **7.00pm** in the presbytery. The important thing to remember is that we are all called to be evangelizers and to spread the Good News of Jesus Christ.
