Most Holy Body & Blood of Christ

Fr. Duncan writes: Today we celebrate the Feast of Corpus Christi, the Body and Blood of Christ. It is a time to reflect and celebrate in greater depth and with sharper awareness what we do each week as we come to Mass. We come together to give thanks to God for His Greatest Gift to us, His Son Jesus Christ, in the great Sacrament of the Eucharist. Since the very early days of the Church the early Christians have been gathering together for this sacred meal. When we routinely do anything, we can lose sight of just how wonderful it is. On this Feast of Corpus Christi, we are reflecting on just how wonderful it is to be called by the Lord to gather in his presence, to be a guest at his table, and to eat and drink from his wonderful bounty. As we come together to celebrate this Mass we are accepting the Lord's invitation and communing with him in this mystery by receiving the sacrament of his body and blood.

This Sunday at the **10.00am** Mass we welcome our First Communion children, dressed in their finery, and their parents for their Thanksgiving Mass. They are coming together as a group to give thanks to God for the Gift of his Son in the Sacrament of Holy Communion.

Please Note the third Mass this Sunday morning will be at **12.00 noon**.

On Friday this week we celebrate the Feast of the Most Sacred Heart of Jesus, our Parish Feast Day. We focus on the heart as the great symbol of love and compassion. As we celebrate this feast, we are reminded of the Sacred Heart of Jesus, God's Son who loves us so intensely and deeply. Let us also remember all our parishioners and benefactors who have gone before us, marked with the sign of faith. May they rest in peace.
