10th Sunday of Ordinary Time

Fr. Duncan writes: After celebrating various feasts over the past few weeks, this Sunday we return to the Sundays of Ordinary Time. It is during these Sundays of the Year that we journey with Christ, listening to him as he travels around preaching and teaching the people. The gospels tell us about various incidents in the life and ministry of Jesus Christ. Each week we listen to what Jesus has to say to us. Although the gospels were written many centuries ago, they are still relevant to us and speak to us now in 2018. This year we are reading from the Gospel of Mark.

Receiving Holy Communion

Following our celebration of Corpus Christi last weekend, it is useful to look carefully again at our reception of Holy Communion. Every now and again we need to look at things we do regularly to ensure no bad habits have crept in. When we come forward to receive Holy Communion, it is important that we follow the correct procedure. We come and stand before the minister, who holds up the host and says; 'The Body of Christ', we respond 'Amen' – 'I Believe'. The host is then placed on our hand or tongue. If we receive in the hand, we place the host in our mouth before moving away. If we wish to receive from the chalice, the minister will say; 'The Blood of Christ', again we respond 'Amen', take hold of the chalice and take a small sip. We spend a great deal of time teaching the children the correct way to receive Holy Communion. They will follow our example and so we need to ensure we receive Jesus in the Sacrament of the Eucharist in a reverent and dignified manner.

St. Edmund Campion Relic

On **Wednesday 4th July at 10am** Mass and **Friday 6th July at 8pm** Mass the Relic of St Edmund Campion will be brought to our church. Each year the Relic of St Edmund Campion is carried from Lyford Grange, near Wantage, where St Edmund was arrested and brought on pilgrimage to Tyburn where he was executed. This pilgrimage is organised each year by the Knights of St Columba and the relic comes to various churches on route to Tyburn Convent. We have the honour of receiving the relic here in our parish. At the end of each Mass there will be the opportunity to venerate the relic.
