Holiday of Obligation

On Friday we celebrate the Feast of Saints Peter and Paul, two great pillars of the Church, two founding members of the Christian Faith. Peter, a fisherman turned leader and Paul, Christian persecutor turned Christian preacher. Both these men were transformed when they came into a closer relationship with God. As we celebrate this feast let us remember our Holy Father, Pope Francis. We pray for him that his faith may be strengthened as he leads and guides the Church. Masses in our church for the Holiday of Obligation are **Thursday 8.00pm** (Vigil Mass) and **Friday at 8.00am, 10.00am and 8.00pm**.

St. Edmund Campion Relic
