## 30<sup>th</sup> Sunday of Ordinary Time

**Fr. Duncan writes:** On Thursday this week we celebrate the Feast of All Saints, a Holy Day of Obligation. Masses for the Feast are on **Wednesday 8.00pm, Thursday 8.00am, 10.00am and 8.00pm**. This feast gives us an opportunity to praise God for all those people, who in day-to-day life have responded to the challenge presented in the Gospel. They have responded generously to what God has asked of them. We remember, with gratitude and joy, all those who have gone before us in faith and are now enjoying the reward of their labours in the kingdom of heaven.

**Friday 2<sup>nd</sup> November**, is the Commemoration of All Souls, when we remember all those who have died, and 'gone before us marked with the sign of faith'. Masses are at **8.00am, 10.00am and 8.00pm**. On this day and throughout the month of November we pray especially for all the souls in purgatory.

November is the month of the Holy Souls when we remember especially those who have died and gone before us 'marked with the sign of faith'. Throughout the month Mass will be offered in our church for all whose names are listed on our November Roll of the Dead. These names will be placed in the sanctuary throughout the month. ### Jubilee Trust Lottery

We have come to that time of year when the Jubilee Trust starts seeking members for our Lottery and the Trustees invite you to take a green letter from the back of the Church. Trustees and helpers will be handing these letter out after Mass this weekend and next weekend.

The Jubilee Trust is our Parish Charity and was set up to mark the Diamond Jubilee of the Parish in 1982. We aim to raise money within the Parish and share that money with others who are less well fortunate than ourselves. We aim to spread Christianity by helping people who are living in poverty or are affected by ill health.

As you may be aware we have had to cancel two of our fundraising events this year due to lack of interest so it would be fantastic if you as a Parishioner can support us in this fundraising effort.

The Lottery is a monthly cash prize draw and is usually held on the third Sunday of the month during the Sunday Morning Coffee. There are 12 prizes ranging from £100 to £500 on the basis that at least 200 people join by paying an annual subscription of £20. Approx. half the money is used by the Jubilee Trust in its work and the other half is given out in prize money. If we exceed 200 people we will attempt to offer additional prizes.

The first draw will be on **16<sup>th</sup> December** after the Carol Service and will be for **£500**.
