31st Sunday of Ordinary Time

Fr. Duncan writes: The work on the roof of Hesdin Hall is progressing well. We pray for some dry weather to enable this work to be completed soon. It is helpful if you can park away from the building whilst the work is going on. Also during this last week, the lights in the car park have been replaced with new LED lights and the lights along the passage behind the hall to the Scout and Guide Hut have been upgraded.

Next Sunday is Remembrance Sunday, when we pray for all those men and women who have lost their lives through war that we might live together in peace and freedom. This year has a special significance as it is the centenary of the ending of the First World War. As we remember those who lost their lives, let us also pray for all those men and women from our country that are at present serving in the armed forces, especially those who are deployed in areas of the world where there is conflict. We pray that they will return safely to their families.

Month of the Holy Souls

November is the month of the Holy Souls when we remember especially those who have died and gone before us 'marked with the sign of faith'. Throughout the month Mass will be offered in our church for all whose names are listed on our November Roll of the Dead. These names will be placed in the sanctuary throughout the month. If you would like the names of your deceased relatives and friends included, please take an envelope from the table at the back of the church and return it with your list enclosed to one of the priests or to the presbytery. Your offering may be placed in the envelope.

Sick & Retired Priests' collection next week

The annual parish collection for the Sick & Retired Priests' Fund takes place next weekend and it is more important than ever that everyone gives as much as they can afford.
