Ss Peter & Paul

Fr. Duncan writes: This weekend we celebrate the Feast of Saints Peter and Paul, two great pillars of the Church, two founding members of the Christian Faith. Peter, a fisherman turned leader and Paul, Christian persecutor turned Christian preacher. Both these men were transformed when they came into a closer relationship with God. As we celebrate this feast let us remember our Holy Father, Pope Francis. We pray for him that his faith may be strengthened as he leads and guides the Church.

We also pray for the Archbishop elect of Southwark, John Wilson. This weekend he is in Rome to receive his Pallium from the Holy Father. The Pallium is a white woollen strip, worn around the neck, which symbolises the bond between an Archbishop and his Pope.

Receiving Holy Communion

Following our celebration of Corpus Christi last weekend, when we focused on the Sacrament of the Eucharist, it is useful to look carefully again at our reception of Holy Communion. Every now and again we need to look at the things we do regularly to ensure no bad habits have crept in. When we come forward to receive Holy Communion, it is important that we follow the correct procedure. We come and stand before the minister, who holds up the host and says; '**The Body of Christ**', we respond '**Amen**' – 'I Believe'. The host is then placed on our hand or tongue. If we receive in the hand, we place the host in our mouth before moving away. If we wish to receive from the chalice, the minister will say; '**The Blood of Christ**', again we respond '**Amen**', take hold of the chalice and take a small sip. We spend a great deal of time teaching the children the correct way to receive Holy Communion. They will follow our example and so we need to ensure we receive Jesus in the Sacrament of the Eucharist in a reverent and dignified manner.

St. Edmund Campion Relic

On **Wednesday 3rd July at 10am** Mass and **Friday 5th July at 8pm** Mass the Relic of St. Edmund Campion will be brought to our church. Each year the Relic of St. Edmund Campion is carried from Lyford Grange, near Wantage, where St. Edmund was arrested and brought on pilgrimage to Tyburn where he was executed. This pilgrimage is organised each year by the Knights of St Columba and the relic comes to various churches on route to Tyburn Convent. We have the honour of receiving the relic here in our parish. At the end of each Mass there will be the opportunity to venerate the relic.

First Reconciliation & First Holy Communion Preparation 2019/2020

Parents of children currently in Year 2 who will be in Year 3 from September 2019, are invited to pre-register their interest in person with Jo Marsh after any morning Mass next weekend. To enrol on the parish programme you must be a parishioner attending Mass on a regular basis. Children who are not attending a Catholic school must complete the 'Year 2' Sunday Group Class before beginning the programme. We look forward to meeting you.

Young People who are interested in enrolling on the parish confirmation preparation programme are invited to pre-register in person with Jo Marsh after any morning Mass from next Sunday. To enrol you must be in at least Year 8 (starting Year 9 in September 2019). We look forward to meeting you.
