## 28th Sunday in Ordinary Time

**Fr. Duncan writes:** Over the last couple of weeks we have spoken about Stewardship and Planned Giving. If you pay UK income tax, please sign the Gift Aid declaration (in one name only) so that the parish can claim 25p back from the government for every £1 that you donate, at no extra cost to yourself.
