The Presentation of the Lord

Fr. Duncan writes: This *Sunday 2nd February*, is the Feast of the Presentation of the Lord, Candlemas. Forty days ago, we celebrated the Incarnation – the Birth of Our Lord and Saviour, Jesus Christ. We celebrated the coming into the world of the One who is the 'light of all people', the light which darkness could not overpower. Today, we celebrate that day when the parents of Jesus took him to the temple to present and dedicate him to God, as was the custom among the Jews. Among the temple faithful, Jesus' appearance is the fulfilment of their hopes. As his parents brought the child Jesus into the temple, so today we gather in his name to offer praise that our eyes have seen the salvation which God promises to all nations. At this dark time of the year, the welcome symbol of light emphasises the coming of Christ as Light into the world.
