# The Baptism of the Lord

*Fr. Duncan writes:* Today we celebrate the Feast of the Baptism of the Lord. Jesus was baptised in the Jordan by John. We see the revelation to John of the identity of Jesus through the descent of the Holy Spirit and the voice of God the Father from heaven. John the Baptist then steps aside in order that God might work directly among his people in the person of his Son, Jesus Christ. When Jesus is baptised in the Jordan, he receives the power of the Spirit to begin his ministry. The Feast of the Baptism of the Lord marks the beginning of the public mission of Jesus. It will be a mission of service to others and hence the fulfilment of his Father's will.

In a couple of weeks, we will celebrate for the first time, **Sunday of the Word of God** on **26**<sup>th</sup> **January**. This is a new feast instituted by Pope Francis to be devoted to the celebration, study and dissemination of the Word of God. We will celebrate this in our parish by inviting our readers to be recommissioned on that day. We are also inviting families to bring their bibles to Mass on that Sunday to be blessed. Many of our young people in secondary schools have a bible – they could bring these in to be blessed. The Holy Father is calling us to focus on how we listen to God speaking directly to each one of us in the scriptures.

### **Walsingham Association**

The Walsingham Association exists primarily to spread devotion to Our Lady of Walsingham and encourage pilgrimage to her Shrine. The Association was founded in 1933, and now has some 50 branches throughout the country. We have a branch of the Walsingham Association in our parish. There is a small group who meet to pray together. Would you like to join us? We meet on the third Friday of the month at **7.15pm** to pray together and so deepen our relationship with Our Blessed Lady. Please come and join us on *Friday 17<sup>th</sup> January at 7.15pm*.
