6th Sunday in Ordinary Time

Fr. Duncan writes: In order to help us prepare for the Act of Re-dedication to Mary, we are invited to participate in a 'Do-it-Yourself' retreat - 33 Days to Morning Glory, a simple daily prayer for 33 days. There are copies of this booklet available in the porch. In order to complete the retreat by the Feast of the Annunciation on 25th March we need to begin next Friday 21st February. There is a clear introduction in the booklet to guide us. There is no charge for these booklets. If you would like to make a donation, please put the money in the papers box.

On the Sunday following the Feast of the Annunciation this year, 29th March, we are being invited to join an Act of Re-dedication to Mary. We will do this at 4.00pm in our church by coming together to support each other with our prayer. This gift of the personal faith of the people of our parish will unite us to the country as we seek once again the prayers and protection of the Mother God. In order to prepare for the Re-dedication, the statue of Our Lady of Walsingham from the Slipper Chapel has been visiting every Catholic Cathedral in the country. The Slipper Chapel statue will visit Westminster Cathedral from $19^{th} - 22^{nd}$ March. I have put a copy of the programme of the visit on the board in the porch.
