# 7th Sunday in Ordinary Time

*Fr. Duncan writes:* In order to help us prepare for the Act of Re-dedication to Mary, we are invited to participate in a 'Do-it-Yourself' retreat – **33 Days to Morning Glory**, a simple daily prayer for 33 days. There are copies of this booklet available in the porch. In order to complete the retreat by the Feast of the Annunciation on **25**<sup>th</sup> *March* we need to have started last *Friday 21st February*. There is a clear introduction in the booklet to guide us. There is no charge for these booklets. If you would like to make a donation, please put the money in the papers box.

#### **Act of Dedication to Mary**

On the Sunday following the Feast of the Annunciation this year, **29**<sup>th</sup> **March**, we are being invited to join an *Act of Re-dedication to Mary*. We will do this at **4.00pm** in our church by coming together to support each other with our prayer. This gift of the personal faith of the people of our parish will unite us to the country as we seek once again the prayers and protection of the Mother God. In order to prepare for the Re-dedication, the statue of Our Lady of Walsingham from the Slipper Chapel has been visiting every Catholic Cathedral in the country. The Slipper Chapel statue will visit Westminster Cathedral from **19**<sup>th</sup> – **22**<sup>nd</sup> **March**. I have put a copy of the programme of the visit on the board in the porch.

#### **Ash Wednesday**

Wednesday this week is Ash Wednesday, the beginning of the Season of Lent. Masses on Ash Wednesday are at **8.00am**, **10.00am** and **8.00pm**. Ashes will be blessed and distributed at each Mass. Please Note: Ash Wednesday is a day of Fasting and Abstinence.

During Lent, it is traditional for us to 'give up' something we like, as a penance. This we should all try to do. Fasting is an important way to keep Lent. But I would also like to encourage you to be positive and take on something extra during Lent as well. This is part of our spiritual preparation for the celebration of Christ's Resurrection at Easter. During Lent, we are encouraged to take on an extra spiritual exercise or devotion, for example coming to weekday Mass, maybe some spiritual reading or walking the Stations of the Cross. Here in our parish during Lent we will be having Stations of the Cross each Friday at **7.30pm** followed by Mass at **8.00pm**. We will also have Stations of the Cross on some Sunday afternoons during Lent. Details will be in the newsletter. Now is the time for us to decide what we will be doing during Lent this year. Then we will be ready to begin on Wednesday.

## A Word for Lent – Faith Sharing using the Sunday Gospels

Reading, reflecting and discussing the six Sunday Gospels during Lent. There will be one session a week, with scripture, prayer, stories and questions for reflection. Week One sessions take place, in the Coffee Lounge, on either: *Monday 24<sup>th</sup> February* at *2pm* or *Wednesday 26<sup>th</sup> February* at *7pm*. Please register, at the back of the Church, for enough resources to be provided.

#### **Lenten Alms**

These are collected throughout Lent. This year the Cardinal has decided that the money will be used to support the Cardinal's Appeal. This money is used within our Diocese to support among other things, evangelisation and formation of our young people and promotion and strengthening of marriage and family life. There is a box by the second Station for Lenten Alms donations.

#### **Lectio Divina**

Inspired by the Year of the Word, we will be setting aside time on a *Tuesday* morning at *10.45am* for **Lectio Divina** – prayerful reading, meditation and contemplation of the Word of God. Each week we will reflect on the following Sunday's Gospel. All are welcome – please do join us.
