**Fr. Duncan writes:** This Sunday should be the second of our Parish First Communion Sundays. This week 37 of our younger parishioners should be receiving Jesus for the first time in the Sacrament of the Eucharist. Because of the coronavirus all our churches are closed and so this celebration will be postponed and will, hopefully, take place in the autumn. We will have to wait for further news and instructions. Today, as last week, we have a special Children's Liturgy for the children and their families. Please pray for them, their parents and catechists this weekend. They will complete their preparations when we are able to bring them together as a group in the church again. I am particularly grateful to Jo Marsh and her team of catechists, who have been teaching the children and have prepared them to receive this Sacrament. Please keep them all in your prayers.

This *Thursday* we celebrate the Feast of **ASCENSION OF THE LORD**. A couple of years ago, the Bishops returned this feast to its proper day, 40 days after Easter and the celebration of the Resurrection. Although, The Ascension is a Holyday of Obligation but this year because of the pandemic our obligation to attend Mass is removed. The Feast of the Ascension is a celebration of the promise of the Lord to be with us always and not simply a commemoration of the departure of the Lord. It is this promise that ensures the effectiveness of our mission as Church, the people of God, to preach the gospel to all nations. We gather as the Church in obedience to Christ. We do so in the joyful celebration of Christ's Ascension. We do so in the knowledge that he promised to be with us always. Today our task is to be living witnesses of his presence and his love as we reach out helping and supporting one another.

#### Thy Novena to the Holy Spirit

Between the Ascension and Pentecost, the apostles gathered together in the upper room waiting for the coming of the Holy Spirit. These nine days of prayer is the original Novena. We will pray this Novena of Prayer each day beginning on *Friday 22<sup>nd</sup> May* and ending on *Saturday 30<sup>th</sup> May*, the Vigil of Pentecost. Each day you are invited to join us at *11.30am* to say the Novena Prayers. We will then end with the Angelus.
