The Most Holy Trinity

Fr. Duncan writes: On this feast of the Most Holy Trinity, we are reminded that our faith is Trinitarian. We follow Jesus Christ, not merely as a historical figure who lived and walked on the earth over 2000 years ago, but as one who is alive today bringing about salvation. The Feast of the Trinity is a celebration of God as the One who calls us together as a community, guides and protects us, and remains with us through the presence of the Holy Spirit. God is not isolated or remote. Beginning with baptism, believers share a special relationship with the Trinity. God is revealed to us as Father, Son and Holy Spirit, a community of love. Throughout history, God reveals a special love for all people and invites us to respond to that love by fidelity to the demands of the gospel. As we gather together to worship the God of creation, we gratefully embrace the challenges we receive as we continue the mission of Jesus in our world. By our lives, therefore, let us bear witness to the God of love. When we were baptised, we were baptised "In the name of the Father and of the Son and of the Holy Spirit", the name of the Trinity and were welcomed as members of the Church. As believers, we are called upon to share that unique family bond with others.

Next **Sunday 14th June** we celebrate the feast of CORPUS CHRISTI, the Body and Blood of Christ.

We are still waiting for news regarding the opening of the churches. Our hope is that we will be permitted to open the church for 'individual prayer' in the near future. This will only be possible under very strict guidelines. We are making suitable preparations to welcome people into the church and keep them safe.
