Fr. Duncan writes: It was wonderful to see so many people coming to Mass last weekend and during the past week. Everybody was delighted to be able return to our church for the celebration of Mass. The booking system worked quite well. We were able to welcome everyone who came to the church, including those who arrived without a reservation. We now understand much more clearly how it works, when applied to our parish. There will be a basic number of places offered each week based on the number the church can now seat. But, as we see how the 'bookings' come in, we are able to release extra seats. These will be released on Fridays. This means that if the Mass you wanted to attend is full, look again on Friday or Saturday – there may be extra seats available.

Approaching the altar to receive Holy Communion

Please approach in single file down the side aisles or centre aisle maintain 2 metres distance. The stewards will invite you to come forward. Please do not leave your bench until invited to do so by the steward. When you stand before the minister, extend your arms out with the palm of your hand up, making a throne to receive Our Lord, while maintaining social distancing. Holy Communion will only be given in the hand. The Host will be placed in your hand. You will not need to make a response. Return to your place using the side aisle. I realise that this will cause difficulties for some people. If you feel you cannot receive Our Lord in your hand, please feel free to come forward for a blessing. All advice from bishops regarding the distribution of Holy Communion is being carefully followed.

This is the time for us all to be patient and charitable, so we can all help and support one another through these challenging times.

Stewarding at Mass and Cleaning the church

If we are going to be able to open the church for Mass on Sundays and during the week, we need help. We need to have stewards to welcome people and people to help clean the benches after the Mass. If we do not have sufficient volunteers, we cannot open the church and the number of Masses will have to be reduced. Can you help? We have a number of volunteers who help regularly, but we need more. On a weekday we need people from 9.15am until we close the church at 11.00am. Ideally three people each day, but two will work. On Sundays we need five people for each Mass. Track & Trace

According to the latest guidance, parishes are advised to keep a record of those attending each Mass and their telephone number which can be used to contact parishioners in the event that someone in the congregation tests positive for Covid-19. The guidance clearly states that parishioners and visitors may opt out of sharing their name and contact details. Thus, no one will be compelled to provide their name and number if they do not wish to do so. At each Mass, those who are admitted to the Mass who did not request tickets in advance, will be asked to complete a card/form with their contact details. Please note that this is not obligatory. These contact cards will be placed in a sealed envelope and kept in a secure place for 21 days. After 21 days, the contents of the envelope will be destroyed in a secure manner.
