# 29th Sunday in Ordinary Time

*Fr. Duncan writes:* As winter approaches, it is time to think about putting the heating on. Having been given guidance about this – there are some difficulties. In order to keep the church Covid safe, we are required to have the windows open. Secondly, our heating system has fans to circulate the heat – we are not permitted to use these. What I will do is put the heating on early to warm the church and then turn it off and open the windows before parishioners come in. Because the church will not be as warm as we would like, you will need to keep your coats on during Mass. Let us pray for a mild winter!

This weekend we have the last of our First Holy Communion Masses. These should have taken place last May. The celebrations this year are different, smaller, simpler, but very prayerful. These Masses are by invitation only, as the numbers are strictly limited. You will be able to follow the Masses on the live stream. Please pray for the children and their families. I am very grateful to Jo Marsh and her team of catechists for preparing the children to receive this great Sacrament.
