Forty Martyrs of England and Wales

Today **Sunday 25th October** the Catholic Church marks the fiftieth anniversary of the canonisation of Forty Martyrs of England and Wales. These are men and women, religious and lay who died during a dark chapter of English history, when it was illegal to practise the Catholic faith. Today we are able to practice our faith freely, although with some restrictions during this pandemic.

In his homily for the Canonisation Pope Paul VI said: *"We have among the 40 holy Martyrs secular and regular priests, religious of various orders, and of different rank, lay people of very noble descent, as well as of modest condition; we have women who were married, mothers with a family. What unites them all is that interior attitude of fidelity to the call of God asked of them"*.

As we gather to celebrate Mass this weekend, we ask the intercession of the Forty Martyrs to help and support us, especially during this time of pandemic in our lives of today.

Stewarding at Mass and Cleaning the church
