Fr. Duncan writes: Following the Prime Minister's statement last weekend, the country is now in lockdown again. This means that Places of Worship have been forced to close, except for online Masses and funerals. There will not be any public Masses until further notice. During this time, Masses will be celebrated in our church at the normal advertised times and can be accessed through https://www.churchservices.tv/ruislipsacredheart
