The Blessed Sacrament is Exposed as a focus for our prayer. During this time, we must carefully follow the guidance that we have been given. By doing this, hopefully, we will return to the ‘new normal’ in December. We will then be in the season of Advent, preparing to celebrate Christmas. This year our Christmas celebrations will be very different. I will give details in the next week or so.

Month of the Holy Souls

November is the month of the Holy Souls when we remember especially those who have died and gone before us ‘marked with the sign of faith’. Throughout the month Masses will be offered in our church for all whose names are listed on our November Roll of the Dead. These names will be placed in the sanctuary throughout the month. Your offering may be placed in the envelope.
