Palm Sunday

Fr. Duncan writes: Today we begin the most important week in the Church's Year, Holy Week. Today, Palm Sunday, we begin this solemn celebration by recalling Christ's triumphal entry into Jerusalem, when the people laid a 'red carpet' of welcome using their coats and palm branches cut from the trees, to welcome Christ as their King. The note of triumph in the waving of the palm branches does not last long. Christ's true kingship reveals itself on and through the Cross. During Holy Week we celebrate Christ's passion, death and resurrection.

On Thursday, we join Christ at the Lord's Supper, the Passover Meal he celebrated with his disciples. We then go with him to pray at the Altar of Repose – the Garden of Gethsemane, from where he is arrested and taken before Pilate. On Friday, we follow the Lord as he makes his way to Calvary for his crucifixion. But we know that this is not the end, because on Saturday evening and Sunday we gather to celebrate the Resurrection.

This year Holy Week will be very different as we gather to celebrate Christ's entry into Jerusalem. Palms will be blessed at the beginning of each Mass on Sunday. We will not be able to process as is normal. An additional supply of Palms will be placed outside the church for people who are unable to come to Mass to collect and pass on to others. There should be plenty for all.

Last year, the Holy Week Masses and services were celebrated in our church, behind closed doors. This year we can gather to celebrate as a community. On Thursday, we join Christ at the Lord's Supper, the Passover Meal he celebrated with his disciples. On Friday, we follow the Lord as he makes his way to Calvary for his crucifixion. But we know that this is not the end, because on Saturday evening and Sunday we gather to celebrate the Resurrection. If you wish to come to any of the Holy Week Services in our church, you must book a place. We cannot guarantee you will be admitted without a reservation. We will do our best, but when the church is full the doors will be closed.

Chrism Mass

The Chrism Mass will be celebrated this *Tuesday 30th March* in Westminster Cathedral. This year it is by invitation only, because of numbers the Cathedral can accommodate. It is during the Chrism Mass, which our Archbishop celebrates with the bishops and priests of the diocese, that the priests renew their priestly commitment. Also, during the Chrism Mass, the Bishop blesses the oils of the Sick and the Catechumens and Consecrates the oil of Chrism. These are the oils that will be used throughout our diocese during the coming year. Please pray for our Archbishop, Cardinal Vincent Nichols, our Auxiliary Bishops and our priests, especially on Tuesday as they gather to celebrate the Chrism Mass.

These are available from this weekend in the porch. Please take an envelope and return it with your offering on Easter Sunday or before then if you are going away. It is the Easter and Christmas offerings that make up the annual salary of our priests. Many thanks for your generosity.

If you are a taxpayer or make a regular donation, we can claim back the tax, which will add an extra 25p to every £1.00 at no cost to you. It only involves a simple form.
- If you could make a regular donation through Bankers Order, please complete a form, this will take away the worry of remembering your donation each week.
- Alternatively, you may wish to donate through Envelopes at the offertory of the Mass, if so, you can sign up today and pledge a regular amount each week.
