Corpus Christi

Fr. Duncan writes: Today we celebrate the Feast of Corpus Christi, the Body and Blood of Christ. It is a time to reflect and celebrate in greater depth and with sharper awareness what we do each week as we come to Mass. We come together to give thanks to God for His Greatest Gift to us, His Son Jesus Christ, in the great Sacrament of the Eucharist. Since the very early days of the Church the early Christians have been gathering together for this sacred meal. When we routinely do anything, we can lose sight of just how wonderful it is. On this Feast of Corpus Christi, we are invited to reflect on just how wonderful it is to be called by the Lord to gather in his presence, to be a guest at his table, and to eat and drink from his wonderful bounty. As we come together to celebrate our Mass each week we are accepting the Lord's invitation and communing with him in this mystery by receiving the sacrament of his body and blood. The best way to thank God for this great gift is to receive Holy Communion worthily and as often as possible. As we celebrate this feast, let us pray also for those who are separated from the Sacrament of the Eucharist, for many different reasons.

Because of the pandemic, over the past year it has not been possible for many people to come to Mass and receive Holy Communion as often as they would like. We are very fortunate to be able to 'livestream' Mass to them each day. We welcome them to our celebration so they can participate as fully as possible in the celebration. I know this is valued, especially by the housebound who do not get out at all. Today, let us pray for all people that they are fed and nourished by the Lord both in the Sacrament and Spiritually

On Friday this week **11th June**, we celebrate the Feast of the Most Sacred Heart of Jesus, our Parish Feast Day. We focus on the heart as the great symbol of love and compassion. As we celebrate this feast, we are reminded of the Sacred Heart of Jesus, God's Son who loves us so intensely and deeply. Let us pray for all in our parish, especially the sick and housebound and the bereaved. Let us also remember all our parishioners and benefactors who have gone before us, marked with the sign of faith. May they rest in peace. There will be two Masses in our church on Friday, **10.00am** and **8.00pm**. There is no Friday abstinence on this day. As the Masses will be busy, please register using Eventbrite to ensure we can welcome all who wish to attend.

Thank you for the many cards that continue to arrive and all your prayers and Masses that have been offered for me. Treatment is going to plan and I am getting stronger each day.

New Arrangements

Following the easing of the lockdown rules, the bishops have suggested we can make some changes to the arrangements in church. You will not need to register for weekday Mass, unless it is a Feast Day. You can register for track and trace as you enter the church using either the QR code on the door or the list on the table. **You will still need to register for Sunday Masses (Saturday 6.00pm, Sunday 9.00am, 10.30am, 12.00 noon and 6.00pm) as before.** This is to ensure we keep within the Covid secure capacity of our church. On weekdays the church will be open from about **9.00am** and be locked after the morning Mass. Please ensure you sanitise your hands as you enter the church and wear your facemask.
