Pentecost

Fr. Duncan writes: This weekend we celebrate Pentecost Sunday, the last day of the Easter Festival. This is the day the Church's work of bringing the Gospel to all peoples began. We come together, like the Lord's disciples at the first Pentecost, in response to our Lord's instructions, to celebrate our birth as the Church. We are the people of the new covenant, called to announce God's almighty works of creation and salvation by our behaviour in our daily lives, inspired by the Holy Spirit. Pentecost is a missionary feast. This is the day that the Church received its call to mission. Today it is the Spirit that gives energy to the Church in proclaiming the Risen Christ. God's Spirit is among us, inspiring us and uniting us, that we too may be apostles of God's love. As we celebrate this great feast, let us hear and respond to its call to mission, to proclaim the truth and joy of the Gospel. And so, let us pray, on this Pentecost Sunday, for a re-awakening of the fire of the Holy Spirit in our hearts and in our lives. We ask the Spirit to empower and energise us as we look at the needs of our parish community and then initiate ways of addressing those needs.

I am very grateful for all the prayers being offered for me. Progress is being made and I am getting stronger each day. Thank you also for the many cards and Masses that have been offered for me. Please keep me in your prayers.

New Arrangements

Following the easing of the lockdown rules that came into operation last week, the bishops have suggested we can make some changes to the arrangements in church. **From this coming Monday 24th May you will not need to register for weekday Mass, unless it is a Feast Day.** You can register for track and trace as you enter the church using either the QR code on the door or the list on the table. **You will still need to register for Sunday Masses (Saturday 6.00pm, Sunday 9.00am, 10.30am, 12.00 noon and 6.00pm) as before.** This is to ensure we keep within the Covid secure capacity of our church. On weekdays the church will be open from about **9.00am** and be locked after the morning Mass. Please ensure you sanitise your hands as you enter the church and wear your facemask.

Stewarding

To enable us to open the church following the first lockdown, we have been supported by a great team of stewards. These generous men and women have helped to ensure that the church is a place of welcome and safety during this time of pandemic in our country. I am very grateful to all those who help regularly each week. Over the weeks, different people have had to give up for many, very valid reasons. This means our pool of helpers is getting smaller. Can you please help. **We will still need stewards at the weekends.** What this involves is to come about 20 minutes before Mass, welcome people and guide them to a seat. The stewards also help guide the people for the reception of Holy Communion. Please come and join our team and help us and your fellow parishioners in this way.
