The Most Holy Trinity

Fr. Duncan writes: On this feast of the Most Holy Trinity, we are reminded that our faith is Trinitarian. We follow Jesus Christ, not merely as a historical figure who lived and walked on the earth over 2000 years ago, but as one who is alive today bringing about salvation. The Feast of the Trinity is a celebration of God as the One who calls us together as a community, guides and protects us, and remains with us through the presence of the Holy Spirit. God is not isolated or remote. Beginning with baptism, believers share a special relationship with the Trinity. God is revealed to us as Father, Son and Holy Spirit, a community of love. Throughout history, God reveals a special love for all people and invites us to respond to that love by fidelity to the demands of the gospel. In his pastoral letter last week, Cardinal Vincent reminded us 'Our world, God's creation, is a precious gift to us'. As we gather together to worship the God of creation, we gratefully embrace the challenges we receive as we continue the mission of Jesus in our world. By our lives, therefore, let us bear witness to the God of love. When we were baptised, we were baptised "In the name of the Father and of the Son and of the Holy Spirit", the name of the Trinity and were welcomed as members of the Church. As believers, we are called upon to share that unique family bond with others.

Next Sunday 6th June we celebrate the feast of CORPUS CHRISTI, the Body and Blood of Christ.

I am very grateful for all the prayers being offered for me. Progress is being made and I am getting stronger each day. Thank you also for the many cards and Masses that have been offered for me. Please keep me in your prayers.

New Arrangements

Following the easing of the lockdown rules, the bishops have suggested we can make some changes to the arrangements in church. You will not need to register for weekday Mass, unless it is a Feast Day. You can register for track and trace as you enter the church using either the QR code on the door or the list on the table. You will still need to register for Sunday Masses (Saturday 6.00pm, Sunday 9.00am, 10.30am, 12.00 noon and 6.00pm) as before. This is to ensure we keep within the Covid secure capacity of our church. On weekdays the church will be open from about 9.00am and be locked after the morning Mass. Please ensure you sanitise your hands as you enter the church and wear your facemask.

Stewarding

To enable us to open the church following the first lockdown, we have been supported by a great team of stewards. These generous men and women have helped to ensure that the church is a place of welcome and safety during this time of pandemic in our country. I am very grateful to all those who help regularly each week. Over the weeks, different people have had to give up for many, very valid reasons. This means our pool of helpers is getting smaller. Can you please help? We will still need stewards at the weekends. What this involves is to come about 20 minutes before Mass, welcome people and guide them to a seat. The stewards also help guide the people for the reception of Holy Communion. Please come and join our team and help us and your fellow parishioners in this way.
