13th Sunday in Ordinary Time

Fr. Duncan writes: This is the time of the year when men are ordained to the diaconate and priesthood. Last Thursday, I celebrated my 32nd anniversary of ordination. During the next month or so, men will be ordained as priests to serve in various dioceses around the country. Please keep all those who are studying at the different seminaries here in England and abroad in your prayers. We also pray that many more men will hear and answer God's call to serve as priests.

Yesterday four men were ordained as priests to serve us in our diocese. Among them was William Johnstone, who was with us here in Ruislip a couple of years ago. Please keep him and all the new priests in your prayers as they begin this new stage in their ministry.

Feast of SS Peter and Paul

On Tuesday we celebrate the Feast of SS Peter and Paul, two great pillars of the Church, two founding members of the Christian Faith. Peter, a fisherman turned leader and Paul, Christian persecutor turned Christian preacher. Both these men were transformed when they came into a closer relationship with God. As we celebrate this feast let us remember our Holy Father, Pope Francis. We pray for him that his faith may be strengthened as he leads and guides the Church.

Sacred Heart School will be joining us online at the 10am Mass.

Masses for the feast are on Monday at 8.00pm and Tuesday at 10.00am and 8.00pm.

New Arrangements

Following the easing of the lockdown rules, the bishops have suggested we can make some changes to the arrangements in church. **You will not need to register for weekday Mass, unless it is a Feast Day.** You can register for track and trace as you enter the church using either the QR code on the door or the list on the table. **You will still need to register for Sunday Masses (Saturday 6.00pm, Sunday 9.00am, 10.30am, 12.00 noon and 6.00pm) as before.** This is to ensure we keep within the Covid secure capacity of our church. On weekdays the church will be open from about **9.00am** and be locked after the morning Mass. Please ensure you sanitise your hands as you enter the church and wear your facemask.
