# Arrangements for coming to Mass

You will not need to register for weekday Mass, unless it is a Feast Day. You can register for track and trace as you enter the church using either the QR code on the door or the list on the table. You will still need to register for Sunday Masses (Saturday 6.00pm, Sunday 9.00am, 10.30am, 12.00 noon and 6.00pm) as before. This is to ensure we keep within the Covid secure capacity of our church. On weekdays the church will be open from about **9.00am** and be locked after the morning Mass. Please ensure you sanitise your hands as you enter the church and wear your facemask.

To enable us to open the church following the first lockdown, we have been supported by a great team of stewards. These generous men and women have helped to ensure that the church is a place of welcome and safety during this time of pandemic in our country.
