16th Sunday in Ordinary Time

Fr. Duncan writes: Following the Prime Ministers announcements on Monday this week, regarding the removing of restrictions to combat the spread of the coronavirus, we are looking very carefully how this will affect us in our parish. The most important thing we have to do is to take personal responsibility for our actions and how they impact on our brothers and sisters, especially those who join us at Mass. We are being encouraged to continue to wear our masks in enclosed places, this includes – in the church – we also need to sanitise our hands as we enter the church. If you are comfortable doing so, you may join your family and friends in the same bench.

As this is being written, I am awaiting advice from the Bishop's Conference and from the Diocese as to how we should proceed. At the moment, let us keep to the ways we have become accustomed to when we come into the church. As we have seen the virus is still very active and continues to spread. It is prudent to move slowly and with caution. At present we will maintain the social distanced seating in the church until we are advised otherwise. These arrangements will be reviewed when we hear from the bishops. Any changes will take place gradually and will not be implemented until next weekend at the earliest.

Livestream

I am sorry to report that the live stream is having problems. As this is being written we are awaiting the engineers to repair the fault. I apologise for the difficulties this will cause.

Arrangements for coming to Mass

The arrangements for coming to Mass have not changed. You will not need to register for weekday Mass, unless it is a Feast Day. You can register for track and trace as you enter the church using either the QR code on the door or the list on the table. **You will still need to register for Sunday Masses (Saturday 6.00pm, Sunday 9.00am, 10.30am, 12.00 noon and 6.00pm) as before.** This is to ensure we keep within the Covid secure capacity of our church. On weekdays the church will be open from about **9.00am** and be locked after the morning Mass. Please ensure you sanitise your hands as you enter the church and wear your facemask.

Stewarding

Help! We are in need of more stewards to help with the weekend Masses. We have been supported by a great team of stewards for many months. These generous men and women have helped to ensure that the church is a place of welcome and safety during this time of pandemic in our country. I am very grateful to all those who help regularly each week. Over the weeks, different people have had to give up for many, very valid reasons. This means our pool of helpers is getting smaller. Can you please help. We will still need stewards at the weekends. What this involves is to come about 20 minutes before Mass, welcome people and guide them to a seat. The stewards also help guide the people for the reception of Holy Communion. Please come and join our team and help us and your fellow parishioners in this way.
