24th Sunday in Ordinary Time

Fr. Duncan writes: For the next two weekends we will celebrate our Parish First Holy Communion. Next weekend 34 of our younger parishioners will be receiving Jesus for the first time in the Sacrament of the Eucharist. The following weekend 35 children will be receiving Jesus for the first time in the great Sacrament of the Eucharist. Please pray for them, their parents and catechists as they complete their preparations for these special days. Rehearsals will take place on the Thursday evenings. These rehearsals are very important to ensure the children and their parents understand fully what is involved. **If a family are not at the rehearsal – they will not be able to join the celebration next weekend.** I am particularly grateful to Jo Marsh and her team of catechists, who have been teaching the children and have prepared them to receive this Sacrament. Please keep them all in your prayers. These Masses are by invitation only, because of the limited space available in the church.

After the removal of certain restrictions to combat the spread of Covid 19, we need to bear in mind that the virus is still spreading. In the church we are doing our best to create a safe environment to welcome all who come to Mass. This means that many of the measures we have put in place will remain, and we will keep to the ways we have become accustomed to when we come into the church. We have been advised to move slowly and with caution. The key actions we have been doing significantly reduce the spread of infection. At present, please continue to wear facemasks in the church and sanitise your hands as you enter the church. If you are comfortable doing so, you may join your family and friends in the same bench. We will maintain the social distanced seating until we are advised otherwise.

Arrangements for coming to Mass

The arrangements for coming to Mass have not changed. You will not need to register for weekday Mass, unless it is a Feast Day. You can register for track and trace as you enter the church using either the QR code on the door or the list on the table. **You will still need to register for Sunday Masses (Saturday 6.00pm, Sunday 9.00am, 10.30am, 12.00 noon and 6.00pm) as before.** This is to ensure we keep within the Covid secure capacity of our church.
