25th Sunday in Ordinary Time

Fr. Duncan writes: This week 34 of our younger parishioners will be receiving Jesus for the first time in the great Sacrament of the Eucharist. Next weekend a further 35 children will be receiving Jesus for the first time in the Sacrament of the Eucharist. Our Parish First Holy Communion days are important not just for the children and their families, but for all in our parish. Many of us will remember our First Holy Communion day. Each time we come to Mass we are encouraged to receive Holy Communion. Being fed and nourished by the Lord in Word and Sacrament is vital in our lives. Please pray for these children, their parents and catechists as they complete their preparations for these special days. Rehearsals will take place on the Thursday evenings. **These rehearsals are very important to ensure the children and their parents understand fully what is involved. If the family are not at the rehearsal – they will not be able to join the celebration next weekend.** I am particularly grateful to Jo Marsh and her team of catechists, who have been teaching the children and have prepared them to receive this Sacrament. Please keep them all in your prayers. These Masses are by invitation only, because of the limited space available in the church.

The Covid19 virus is still spreading. We need to be vigilant. In the church we are doing our best to create a safe environment to welcome all who come to Mass. This means that many of the measures we have put in place will remain, and we will keep to the ways we have become accustomed to when we come into the church. Please continue to wear facemasks in the church and sanitise your hands as you enter the church. We will maintain the social distanced seating until we are advised otherwise.

Arrangements for coming to Mass

The arrangements for coming to Mass have not changed. You will not need to register for weekday Mass, unless it is a Feast Day. You can register for track and trace as you enter the church using either the QR code on the door or the list on the table. **You will still need to register for Sunday Masses (Saturday 6.00pm, Sunday 9.00am, 10.30am, 12.00 noon and 6.00pm) as before.** This is to ensure we keep within the Covid secure capacity of our church.
