Fr. Duncan writes: Over the past couple of weeks we have celebrated our Parish First Holy Communions. These were wonderful celebrations. We look forward to seeing these children and their families at Mass regularly now we are getting back to 'normal'. We all need to be fed and nourished by the Lord in Word and Sacrament.

Over the next two weekends we will have the Confirmation Celebrations. Forty of our young parishioners will be receiving the Gifts of the Holy Spirit in the Sacrament of Confirmation. Please pray for these young people, their sponsors and their families.

The Covid19 virus is still spreading. We need to be vigilant. In the church we are doing our best to create a safe environment to welcome all who come to Mass.
