28th Sunday in Ordinary Time

Fr. Duncan writes: This weekend we have the first of our Confirmation Celebrations. Twenty of our young parishioners will be receiving the Gifts of the Holy Spirit in the Sacrament of Confirmation. Next Saturday we have the second Confirmation celebration when another twenty young people will be receiving the Gifts of the Holy Spirit. Please pray for these young people, their sponsors and their families.

The Covid19 virus is still spreading. We need to be vigilant. In the church we are doing our best to create a safe environment to welcome all who come to Mass. This means that many of the measures we have put in place will remain, and we will keep to the ways we have become accustomed to when we come into the church. Please continue to wear facemasks in the church and sanitise your hands as you enter the church. We will maintain the social distanced seating until we are advised otherwise.

Arrangements For Coming To Mass

You will still need to register for Sunday Masses (**Saturday 6.00pm, Sunday 9.00am, 10.30am, 12.00 noon and 6.00pm**) as before. This is to ensure we keep within the Covid secure capacity of our church.

Westminster Synodal Pathway

"The Holy Father is offering us the opportunity to participate in a time of listening and reflecting. He hopes this will help us to discern how God's presence comes into our lives and what the Spirit of God is prompting us to do anew, so that we might be more alive and creative in our response to the call of Jesus, our Way, Truth and Life." (Pastoral Letter 2-3 October 2021, Cardinal Vincent)
