## 32<sup>nd</sup> Sunday in Ordinary Time

Fr. Duncan writes: Next Sunday is Remembrance Sunday, when we pray for all those men and women who have lost their lives through war that we might live together in peace and freedom. As we remember those who lost their lives, let us also pray for all those men and women from our country that are at present serving in the armed forces, especially those who are deployed in areas of the world where there is conflict. We pray that they will return home safely to their families.

Next Saturday evening at **6.00pm** we will have our Annual Bereavement Mass when we welcome all the families of those who have had a loved one buried or cremated from our Church in the past year.

## Month of the Holy Souls

November is the month of the Holy Souls when we remember especially those who have died and gone before us 'marked with the sign of faith'. Throughout the month Masses will be offered in our church for all whose names are listed on our November Roll of the Dead. These names will be placed under the altar throughout the month. If you would like the names of your deceased relatives and friends included, please take an envelope from the table at the back of the church and return it with your list enclosed to one of the priests or to the presbytery. Your offering may be placed in the envelope.
