33rd Sunday in Ordinary Time

Fr. Duncan writes: This weekend we welcome Siobhan Denny to speak at all our Masses about the Synodal Pathway that our Holy Father, Pope Francis, has asked every parish throughout the world to follow in preparation for the Synod in 2023.

This Sunday is Remembrance Sunday, when we pray for all those men and women who have lost their lives through war that we might live together in peace and freedom. As we remember those who lost their lives, let us also pray for all those men and women from our country that are at present serving in the armed forces, especially those who are deployed in areas of the world where there is conflict. We pray that they will return home safely to their families.

The Covid19 virus is still spreading

We have removed some of the 'social distanced seating' in the church. But, as we listen to the news, Covid is still spreading. This means we still need to be vigilant. We will maintain some social distanced seating on the side aisles for those people who prefer to have more space. Many of the measures we have put in place over the past months will remain at the moment. When you come into the church please continue to wear facemasks and sanitise our hands as you enter the church. Please remember to keep a safe distance as you come forward to receive Holy Communion. There are markers along the aisles to help you. **From this weekend, we will return to the practice saying; 'The body of Christ' as you come to receive the host. You will reply; 'Amen'.**

The arrangements for coming to Mass have changed. You will not need to register for Mass during the week or on Sundays. These arrangements will be continually reviewed.

Synod Church: 2021-2023, Communion, Participation & Mission

As you may already be aware, the pope has called a synod. Pope Francis is calling us to discuss how we can journey together. **"By walking together, and together reflecting on the journey made, the church will be able to learn from what it will experience which processes can help it to live communion, to achieve participation and to open itself to mission"**. Essentially, this is an opportunity to have your thoughts listened to and to listen to others in a safe environment. This is not a debate exercise but a listening one. This is a worldwide process. We will feed back our findings to the diocese of Westminster, who will feed back the diocese findings to the Bishop's conference of England and Wales, who will then feedback their findings to Rome. While the findings being fed back to Rome may be generalized for the country, we are also being asked to take action in our own parish in response to our parishioner's thoughts. There will be four dates that you can sign up to.
