All Saints

Fr. Duncan writes: This Sunday we celebrate the Feast of All Saints, transferred from Monday. This feast gives us an opportunity to praise God for all those people, who in day-to-day life have responded to the challenge presented in the Gospel. They have responded generously to what God has asked of them. We remember, with gratitude and joy, all those who have gone before us in faith and are now enjoying the reward of their labours in the kingdom of heaven.

Tuesday 2nd November, is the Commemoration of All Souls, when we remember all those who have died, and 'gone before us marked with the sign of faith'. Masses are at 8.00am, 10.00am and 8.00pm. On this day and throughout the month of November we pray especially for all the souls in purgatory.

Month of the Holy Souls

November is the month of the Holy Souls when we remember especially those who have died and gone before us 'marked with the sign of faith'. Throughout the month Masses will be offered in our church for all whose names are listed on our November Roll of the Dead. These names will be placed in the sanctuary throughout the month. If you would like the names of your deceased relatives and friends included, please take an envelope from the table at the back of the church and return it with your list enclosed to one of the priests or to the presbytery. Your offering may be placed in the envelope.

The Covid19 virus is still spreading

We have removed some of the 'social distanced seating' in the church from this weekend. But, as we have all seen in the news over the past couple of weeks, Covid is still spreading. This means we still need to be vigilant. We will maintain some social distanced seating to enable those who prefer to have more space on the side aisles. In the church we are doing our best to create a safe environment to welcome all who come to Mass. Many of the measures we have put in place over the past months will remain at the moment. When you come into the church please continue to wear facemasks and sanitise our hands as you enter the church.

The arrangements for coming to Mass have changed. You will not need to register for Mass during the week or on Sundays You can register for track and trace as you enter the church using either the QR code on the door or the list on the table. This is to ensure we are able to welcome people to our church and keep within the Covid secure capacity of our church

Sick & Retired Priests' Fund Collection

Next weekend is the annual collection for sick and retired priests in the Diocese of Westminster. There are more than 80 sick and retired priests who receive support after a lifetime of service to their parishes. By 2025 the number of priests in retirement is set to double.

Most priests offer their resignation as a parish priest at the age of 75, but many continue to serve in our parishes, schools, hospices, and hospitals. At this time, they are dependent on the Diocese for their care – for essentials like housing, any health needs and other essentials.

These priests have baptised us. They have welcomed us, and our families, into the Church. They have counselled us at times of crisis, sat with us through grief and sorrow, and shared in times of joy. They have given to us all and now, in their old age or sickness, they need us to give back.

By giving to the Sick & Retired Priests' Fund, you can ensure our priests are cared for. You can take a donation envelope as you leave Church today, but the envelopes and posters feature a 'QR Code' that you can scan with a phone camera to give online, reducing the risks to everyone of handling cash or touching the envelopes. Please continue to pray for all our clergy: active, retired or ill. Thank you.
