4th Sunday of Advent

Fr. Duncan writes: This Sunday we celebrate the Fourth Sunday of Advent. Next Saturday we celebrate the Feast of the Birthday of our Lord and Saviour Jesus Christ. On Christmas Day at all our Masses my thoughts and prayers will be for the people of our parish, for those visiting our parish at Christmas and for your families, wherever they may be. This has not been an easy year for many people. We have all had to make changes to what we do in our lives, as we continue to cope with the Coronavirus pandemic. At this time of year, we remember especially all of our parishioners who have died and those families who have lost someone close to them during this past year. We appreciate your loss and want you to know that we are thinking of you at this time.

Christmas is very much a children's feast, as it commemorates the birth of the greatest child ever born. It is also very much a family feast as it commemorates the greatest family that ever existed. As we gather to celebrate Mass during this Christmas Season, let us give thanks to God for our families. Let us also pray that we may be kept safe and well during this Christmas and that we are able to meet and celebrate with our families and friends this year.

Christmas Masses

This year Masses for Christmas will be celebrated at 5.30pm, 7.00pm and 10.30pm and 12.00midnight (Malayalam Mass) on Christmas Eve. On Christmas Morning Masses will be celebrated at 9.00am, 10.30am and 12.00 noon. The 5.30pm Mass on Christmas Eve is a children's Mass and the children are invited to come dressed as angels and shepherds. In order to maintain social distancing and to ensure everyone has a seat, we have added extra Masses. PEOPLE WILL NOT BE PERMITTED TO STAND AT THE BACK OF THE CHURCH. It is worth bearing in mind, that Christmas has an Octave. This means eight days of celebration. If you cannot come on Christmas Day, you are welcome to come later in the week and celebrate Christmas.

Covid19 Procedures

As we heard, Covid is still spreading and now with this new strain of the virus at an alarming rate. This means we have to be even more vigilant and careful. We have been advised by the Bishops; *that* people displaying any symptoms of covid should stay at home and not travel to church. That hand sanitiser is available to those attending Church. Face coverings must be worn by those attending public acts of worship unless there is a genuine exemption or the person is leading worship or participating in a role that requires the mask to be removed for a period of time. That there is good ventilation and air throughout in the building; in this case, because of climatic conditions, it would be important to remind people to wrap up well in church! This means that we will continue with the measures we have in place. We have removed some of the 'social distanced seating' in the church. We will maintain some social distanced seating on the side aisles for those people who prefer to have more space. Please remember to keep a safe distance as you come forward to receive Holy Communion. We have now returned to the practice saying; 'The body of Christ' as you come to receive the host. Please reply; 'Amen'.
