# 1st Sunday of Advent

Fr. Duncan writes: Today we celebrate the First Sunday of Advent, the beginning of the Church's year. This year we will be reading from the gospel of Luke. The season of Advent is a short season of preparation for Christmas, the birth of our Lord and Saviour, Jesus Christ. The chief characteristic of Advent is one of joyful expectation. When you look around you are given the impression that Christmas has already begun. It has not. Advent is the time we use to prepare for Christmas, not only in a practical way, but also in a spiritual way. It is on Christmas night when we welcome the new born king – then Christmas begins.

### The Gift of the Sunday Eucharist – A Statement from the Bishops.

The Sunday Eucharist is a gift; as God's holy people we are called to praise and thank God in the most sublime way possible. When the Church speaks of the Sunday obligation, it reminds us that attending Mass is a personal response to the selfless offering of Christ's love.

At this time, we recognise that for some people there may be certain factors which hinder attendance at Sunday Mass. The pandemic is clearly not over. The risk of infection is still present. For some, there is legitimate fear in gathering together. As your bishops, we recognise that these prevailing circumstances suggest that not everyone is yet in the position to fulfil the absolute duty to freely attend Sunday Mass.

### **Covid19 Procedures**

We have removed some of the 'social distanced seating' in the church. But, as we listen to the news, Covid is still spreading. This means we still need to be vigilant. We will maintain some social distanced seating on the side aisles for those people who prefer to have more space. Please remember to keep a safe distance as you come forward to receive Holy Communion. There are markers along the aisles to help you. We have now returned to the practice saying; 'The body of Christ' as you come to receive the host. You will reply; 'Amen'.
